






The Purpose of The Event

Delegates Requirements

Asia World Model United Nations (AWMUN) IV offers two types of participants, i.e. single delegate and observers, consisting of:

- [®] International Delegates who are enrolled in International Organizations/Institutions/ Companies
- © College/High School Students
- ⊚ Graduates of University/High School (maximum age 25 years old)

In regards to the participants referred to as "observers" can be described as participants that are older than 14 or between 26 - 60 years old. However, these participants will not be given any voice or represent a country during the conference. Should any participants wish to be accompanied by a Faculty Advisor, the Faculty Advisor is required to register as an observer.

Series of Activities

(01) Grand Symposium

Asia World Model United Nations (AWMUN) IV holds a grand symposium during the opening ceremony with the theme of Preserving Peace in A Dynamic Security Dimensions conducted by outstanding speakers that will discuss recent international issues regarding the topic in each council.



MUN 101

Model United Nations Asia World (AWMUN) IV organizes MUN 101 and Zero Conference before the committee sessions start so that the delegates may earn how MUN works and understand the Rules of Procedure deeper. Both MUN 101 and Zero Conference will be explained by our Board of Dais. They will explain and teach the delegates step-by-step procedure of the MUN and they will be discussing interesting topics in the Zero Conference.



Committee Session

Delegates will be assigned to represent a country in each council that has been chosen by the delegates and discuss the particular topic in their council. Delegates will be moderated by the Board of Directors during the committee session.





City Tour

Delegates will be invited to witness the alluring beauty of the Island of Gods, Bali. During the city tour, delegates will be visiting iconic tourism spots exhibiting the captivating cultures of Bali that cannot be found anywhere else.

Councils Overview

Asia World Model United Nations (AWMUN) IV will provide 4 councils with an interesting topic in each council that will be discussed at the conference. Each delegate may choose one council to attend. Another council will reveal after the existing council has been full.

World Health Organization (WHO)

Topic: Addressing Tobacco Free Initiative as a global action plan.

Tobacco is one of the main factors of death caused by non-communicable diseases such as Tuberculosis, Stroke and Lung Cancer. The number of people who died of it keeps escalating every year. The latest data show that an estimated 100 million people from any ages were killed by tobacco used during the 20th century. As part of continuing efforts to improve the health and well-being of people, the World Health Organization member states in Asia World Model United Nations (AWMUN) IV will be addressing the Tobacco-Free Initiatives as a global action plan to work together in order to decrease the use of Tobacco in people's daily life.

United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) Topic: Protection of Displaced Women and Children in Conflict Situation.

One of the mandates of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees is to protect women and children as the most vulnerable group during the conflict situation. Put women and children first means that they have to be saved first in a life-threatening situation. Protection towards women and children in conflict situations means that we have to protect them from violence, war, and ensure that we protect their future. The impact of armed conflict on children, especially infants and young children, cannot be considered in isolation from women. In the committee session of AWMUN IV, the delegates will discuss the protection of displaced women and children in conflict situations. Moreover, women are the primary child caregivers, when they are affected by war, so are children.





Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO)

Topic: Ending World Hunger Through Development of Genetically Modified Organism (GMO)

Food scarcity is one of the world's big homework. The global warming and change of land function has worsened the condition from the ideal. In this invention era, we are keen to develop a genetically modified organism (GMO). GMO is any organism whose genetic material has been altered using genetic engineering techniques. Using GMO is believed could contribute to food production by increasing the quality and higher food availability. Yet, the safe and effective application of GMO to solve the problems of hunger in the third-world, will require reasonable engagement and coordination from FAO member states. It is expected that in AWMUN IV, the FAO could provide great ideas to boost the discussion over the development of GMO.

United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF)

Binding Multilateral Cooperation to Integrated Services for Children with Disability UNICEF has committed to build a more inclusive society for children with disability. It is believed, through integrated services supported by well-prepared specialists in education, children with disability may enjoy daily common experiences essential to the development of a keen awareness of the realities of the world around them. Currently, the implementation of the action is not yet final as it needs the full commitment from UNICEF member states to adhere the multi-cultural cooperation for having an integrated services for children with disability.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Eligibility

- Asia World Model United Nations welcomes youth age of 17 and 25 years old from any country who wish to have experience in Model UN or have high interest in global affairs to be the delegates of Asia World Model United Nations.
- O2 All delegates must be enrolled in High School/University, High School/University graduates, enrolled in International Organizations/Institutions/Companies, or representatives from High School or College.
- All delegates should choose three council preference and 3 country allocations.
- All matters regarding country allocation will be arranged based on the decision of the committee.

Registration Mechanism

- All registrations are accepted based on motivation letter and experience and the result will be announced within 3 x 24 working hours. Once maximum capacity is reached, delegates will be able allocated to their second preferences.
- Registration is opened for two types of accommodations: Full accommodation and Non-Accommodation.







TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Payment

- O1 All fees are Non-Refundable (TnC for refund).
- The provision of payment will be informed in the letter of agreement that will be provided by the committee.

Refund Terms and Conditions

- For cancellation due to sickness, death, natural disasters, and conflict, the delegates will be given a 100% refund maximum 60 days before the event.
- For cancellation due to visa rejection, the delegates will get 100% refund. The delegates should inform approximately 60 days before the event.

 IMPORTANT NOTE: Delegates will be charged for all the fees for international transfers

Visa

- Upon request, successful registrants will be issued a Letter of Invitation from Asia World Model United Nations stating the status of their participation at Asia World Model United Nations after the background check. Registrants may use the Letter of Invitation for their visa acquisition process.
- Asia World Model United Nations will not provide visa and is not responsible for any participant's visa into Malaysia.
